#### **4) Acceptance of Office**

Chair accepted office and signed accordingly. This was witnessed by Cllr Andrew Poppleton.

#### **5) Declarations of Interest (Local Government Act 2011)**

There were no Declarations of Interest.

#### **6) Minutes of previous AGM (July 2020)**

The minutes for the previous AGM had been agreed and signed at the Bi-monthly Meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> November 2020. Reference 20/35.

#### **7) Financial Officers Report**

The Financial Officer reported all relevant Year end paperwork had been emailed to the Councillors prior to the meeting and there were no queries from Council members. All the paperwork was agreed to be accurate and all councillors had read through everything and they had no issues with it.

The Financial Officer confirmed when asked, that the CCTV cameras should not be recorded as Income & Expenditure.

The question was raised regarding the payment for maintenance of the church yard and it was agreed that this would be researched and reported upon at the next meeting.

#### **8) Chairman's Report**

Chair provided an update on the unauthorised construction of a road leading from the old Poultry Farm to Bradley Road. It appears that it is currently not being used whilst under investigation but gaining information on the process of the Enforcement Application is very slow. (Ref EN/0829/20)

Chair reported on a telephone call she had received from a resident regarding her wanting to purchase items from the Shepherds Purse small holding. It seems the call ended rather rudely with the owner of Shepherds Purse putting the phone down. After contact with NELC it was confirmed that the resident in question may follow up with a complaint if she so decides.

An update was also provided on the installation of verge parking restrictions on Bradley Road and part of Church Lane. The application is currently with NELC legal department and dependant on the 21 days notice of consultation to the residents affected, it is hoped it will be concluded by July 2021.

The Chair also reported on her previous suggestion for the Church Committee to apply for funding from the Solar Farm Foundation for installing gas central heating,

rewiring, water and toilet and kitchen facilities at St Georges Church, Bradley. This could be completed in two stages and provide the village with a more useable building. Progress is slow but it was agreed that the suggestion of this project should be pursued by compiling and sending a formal email to the relevant parties.

Chair further updated all present that the CCTV cameras in that they are now up and running and after an issue with one camera not working and another having to be moved slightly. It was stated that enquiries had been made for the cost of arranging an annual check on the cameras. As of the date of this meeting, there had been no reply and so it was agreed that this would be followed up again.

A discussion was held regarding the REM application for 66 dwellings (DM/1084/20/REM) to be located at the end of Bradley Road towards Waltham, and it was reported that the application has been deferred due to the design and style of the housing and for them to be more compliant to the surrounding area.
