22/33 Minutes of the previous Meeting

Minutes of the Bradley Parish Council Bi-monthly meeting held on 3rd March 2022 and the Extra-ordinary meeting held on 24th March 2022 were agreed and signed by the Chair.

Suspension of Meeting by Chair for Public Forum

Chair read out an email that had been received by a member of the public who was unable to attend the meeting tonight, about a large amount of motorbikes riding around Bradley Pitches one Sunday. Reports had been logged with the police. The Chair has spoken to the local PCSO and the Community Officer. It was confirmed that operation Yellow Fin is still in operation and they would be made aware that there is still trouble with bikes in this area. Contact details were passed to the resident for further information to be reported.

22/34 Police Matters

The police report was read by all members of the council and it was agreed that the number of incidents relating to motorbike activity was correct.

After the query with motorbike figures from the previous report, a reply had been received from the Police, stating that many of the logs would be included in the South Ward as the pitches are located in their ward. Chair is going to contact the Councillor of that ward to discuss this matter further.

22/35 Planning Matters

There were no objections to Planning Application DM/0350/22/FUL (Extension to a property at Low Farm Cottages on Bradley Road). Planning Application DM/0366/22/FUL (Development of enclosed field at Netherwood Farm) had been received and further queries would be made regarding the application prior to deciding if there were objections.

22/36 Co-option Applications

Councillors all confirmed that all the applications and information provided by the candidates had been read and considered fairly. A vote took place where each applicant was proposed and seconded, and a vote was taken which was unanimous for the two successful candidates, this vote included an email vote from Cllr Bryden. Both successful candidates will be informed this week and the necessary paperwork will be completed at the next meeting. Unsuccessful candidates will be informed.

22/37 Finance

The RFO asked council members if they had read all paperwork that was sent previously regarding the AGM. This was confirmed and all agreed with the completed paperwork. It was signed accordingly and will be sent to relevant departments by RFO.

The clerks wages were paid and a donation to the church was made for the use of the Church.

BPC Insurance company had provided a further quote and cover to the usual one, and it was agreed by all council members that the new cover would be more suitable for BPC. The RFO will contact them and initiate the new cover.

22/38 Update on Ongoing Issues

Online Banking – The query with the emails has been rectified and the new application will be completed in the following few days.

The new laptop is now up and running and covered by a security system as well as having a one year subscription to MS 365 installed.

Due to an article in the Newsletter a member of the public has volunteered to be the Emergency Contact person for Bradley Village at the end of the village going towards Waltham.

The situation regarding the no parking on the verges signs was discussed again, and although highways have been contacted twice, there has been no reply. This will be followed up again this week.
