#### **24/13 Apologies**

There were no apologies received.

#### **24/14 Declaration of Interest (Local Government Act 2012)**

There were no declarations of Interest.

#### **24/15 Minutes of the previous Meeting**

Minutes of the Bi-monthly Meeting held by Bradley Parish Council on 4<sup>th</sup> January 2024 which were previously sent to all Councillors in draft form. These minutes were all agreed by those that were present at that meeting, and signed by Chair.

### **24/16 Police Matters**

A copy of the Police Report was handed to the Councillors, and it was noted that there was one report of a smashed car window, five assaults and one of harassment. There were also two assaults in the Complex Care Centre and two reports of ASB relating to the same person.

### **24/17 To discuss the proposed Bus Route**

The two representatives from EQUANS reported that the proposal of a new bus route along Bradley Road is receiving some positive feedback. With extra funding being received for improving local bus services the proposal is being considered with other bus route services and improvements. Agents had also been to assess the proposed bus stops.

### **Suspension of Meeting by Chair for Public Forum**

Time Stopped 19:26

Because there were concerns from the members of the public regarding the positioning of the bus stops, it was explained that these are still under review. Also, concerns were given regarding footpaths for the bus stops It was concluded that currently there is reasonable access to existing footpaths. As an update from EQUANS relating to the speeding issue along Church Lane that was mentioned in previous meeting, they informed us that extra 20mph repeaters had been put in place and if this did not deter motorists then to get back in touch to discuss a further solution. Comments were made regarding the condition of Church Lane from the corner where the church is through to the fork. Concerns were given regarding lamping in the area this information has been passed on to the PCSO.

### **24/18 Planning Matters**

The amendment to Planning Application DM/1037/23/FUL to include demolition of existing building on the woodlands site was explained by Chair and it was agreed that BPC had no objection to the amendment.

### **24/19 CCTV Maintenance Contract**

The contract for the maintenance of the CCTV cameras in the village by NELC was presented to the Councillors and it was agreed that they would be serviced once a year by NELC/EQUANS.

### **24/20 Finance**

It was agreed by all Councillors that a lockable holdall could be purchased for the Clerk to contain the Councils laptop and paperwork for extra security. It was agreed that the Microsoft 365 software package could be purchased for another year.

### **24/21 To Discuss the Local Plan**

The local plan was discussed at great length and it was agreed that BPC would write to the Local Plan contact at NELC and object to the proposed building of 40 properties off Church Lane.

### **24/22 Update on Ongoing Issues**

The Chair updated the Councillors on a telephone conversation she has had with the Manager at the Football Complex on Bradley Road and it appears that they are just as frustrated as we are with the parking issues on Bradley Road. It was agreed that BPC will contact the portfolio holder and discuss the ongoing issues and find a solution.

### **24/23 Information Exchange**

A discussion took place about the possibility of acquiring a defibrillator for the parish and where it could be placed. It was agreed that the costings would be looked into by the Clerk and also to look at Emergency Bleeding Kits, and this will be discussed at the next meeting.

### **24/24 Date of Next Meeting**

After a vote to change the date of the next meeting to the second Thursday of the month (due to the local general elections), the date and venue for the next Bradley Parish Council Meeting will be on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> May 2024 starting at 7pm, at St Michaels Church, Great Coates Road and will include the AGM.
