2. Apologies

There were no apologies received.

3. Election of Chairman

5. Acceptance of Office

6. Declarations of Interest (Local Government Act 2011)

7. Minutes of Previous AGM (23rd May 2023)

The minutes for the previous AGM (23-05-23) had been agreed and signed at the Bi-monthly Meeting held on 6th July 2023 (Ref 23/39).

8. Financial Officers Report

The RFO had sent all Councillors via email, copies of all relevant Year End paperwork prior to the meeting for their perusal. There were no queries from Council Members. It was noted that expenditure was up slightly due to the purchase of the bench, but this was covered by the grant from NELC. There was no training required this year. The councillors were updated on the issue of spam email coming through from the website (Vision ICT), and this had finally been rectified with a reCAPTCHA program being installed. It was agreed by all council members to continue with the annual payment to ERNLLCA. The Accounts were approved by all council members to be accurate. All relevant paperwork was then signed and dated accordingly by the Chair, RFO and Parish Clerk.

9. Chairmans Report

Chair reported that there was nothing dramatic that had happened in the previous year. The poppies being purchased were a new venture that on the whole had been received very positively by Bradley residents. The CCTV maintenance contract has finally been approved and signed but as of the date of the meeting, a maintenance check had not been completed.

The problem with parking at the Church Lane entrance to Bradley Woods is still ongoing and after various conversations and emails it has still not been rectified but BPC will continue to try and resolve this issue. Regarding planning, the proposed dog park along Bradley Road has been refused by NELC planning committee and the Barn installation at Woodlands Farm, Church Lane, had not been concluded at the time of this meeting.
