24/66 Retirement of Council Members and Co-option of New Council Members

The resignation of two council members were received and accepted. Files containing Agendas, Minutes and Correspondence and BPC's printer were handed to the Clerk. The bankcard was returned to the RFO. The filing cabinet will be retained by Cllr Poppleton and remaining documents will be placed in archive files at NELC offices. Issues discussed included security, vandalism and taking care of the proposed woodland site.

24/69 Finance

The RFO confirmed that the training course from last month, the vision ICT subscription, clerks wages and flowers for Cllr Turner had been paid for. Filofax pages and polypockets were approved to be ordered for the Clerk. The address has been altered to the RFO's for BPC's bank account.

24/70 To Discuss Newsletter Continuation

There were four parishioners that contacted BPC expressing their wishes to continue with the newsletter. After some discussion it was agreed that we will publish and deliver one more paper copy of the newsletter and inform residents that an emailed version will be considered if a large quantity of residents sign up to receive it. If not, then it will be discontinued.

24/71 Update on Ongoing Issues

It has come to our attention that the 'No Parking' sign has been placed at the rear of Bradley Woods to deter parking on the Bridleway. The request for an extra public bin to be placed in Bradley Woods has been erected. Cllr Dollard has been informed by the farmer that owns the field alongside Church Lane that the hedges will be trimmed in the next few weeks. It was agreed that BPC will fund the cost of the convex mirror that was discussed at previous meetings. Cllr Poppleton is still looking into changing the network for BPC's mobile telephone and researching a better contract.

It was agreed by all Councillors present that the Clerk can research adding an Equal Opportunities Policy and a Complaints Procedure as recommended by ERNLLCA. St Michaels Church has been booked for BPC's bi-monthly meetings for 2025.
