There was nothing listed at the time of the meeting, for May or June. It was pointed out by Cllr Poppleton that many of the crimes within Bradley are located at the Bradley Hospital Complex.

An email had been sent to Humberside Police regarding the Police Surgeries, and BPC put forward the suggestion for a weekend date, or an evening during the week as they would be more suitable for our residents for the surgeries. BPC have still not had a reply so the Clerk will contact them again.

26-43 Planning Matters

At the time of this meeting, there were no new planning applications, other than the ones that have been reported on previously.

26-44 Finance

The RFO reported that the Clerks wages have been paid as usual and BPCs' Insurance has been renewed. There was no update regarding the changes to the Bank Account and the RFO will look into this before the next meeting. It was noted that BPC will be receiving an invoice in the future for the new Domain Regulations.

26-45 Update on Ongoing Issues

The new email addresses have been received for the Councillors and they will set up their personal devices to receive Parish Council emails. This will be listed on the next agenda to approve the changes and personal email addresses will not be used for Parish Council matters from that date.

Although the verges alongside Church Lane, were reported for maintaining, they have still not been done so the Clerk will report them again. All other items raised at the last meeting have been attended to.

The quotes for the noticeboard have been shared with the Councillors, and the Clerk will now continue with the application for funding, and update BPC accordingly. It was noted that posts will also be needed, and this is to be added to the application.

26-46 Information Exchange

The upcoming dates for the Town and Parish Liaison Committee Meetings have been sent to BPC and the clerk will send the Agenda and the future dates, to our Councillors.

As from 29th June 2026 Councillors no longer have to publicise their full address on the Register of Interests due to a new legislation. This will be discussed in more detail at the next meeting, after that date. BPC have received an email relating to the Winter Review for this year, asking for any comments or alterations to the current policy, and it was suggested that placing a grit bin at the junction of Church Lane and Bradley Road would be useful. The clerk will contact NELC to request this.
