#### 20/12 Apologies

No apologies were reported.

#### 20/13 Declaration of Interest (Local Government Act 2012)

No Declarations of Interest given.

#### 20/14 Minutes of the previous Meetings

Minutes of the Bi-monthly Meeting held on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2020 were agreed and signed by Chair.

#### 20/15 Parking along Bradley Road

Possibilities for improving the verge parking problems were addressed by an ENGIE Senior Traffic Team member and three options were presented as follows:

- No Waiting 7 days per week 24 hours a day with signs to warn drivers.

- Limited 'No Parking' Times to coincide with Football Matches and busy periods.
- Posts to be erected to prevent vehicles from parking.

It was pointed out that all the options have pros and cons attached to them and may affect local residents and their visitors. Highways will be consulting with residents and when the way forward has been chosen, Civil Enforcement Officers would be informed of the changes to the road restrictions and they work 7 days per week. Members of the Public were advised to telephone 01472 324514 if vehicles are seen on the verges and Enforcement Officers would be dispatched.

If any residents would like to put forward their option, they are advised to email the Parish Clerk at Bradley Parish Council. (email below)

There has been some concern over the speed of vehicles along Church Lane and consequently a discussion was held with Highways regarding the possibility of placing a 'STOP sign' at the exit from Bradley Farm Mews but highways informed us that was not an option so they will look into a possibility of a 'Give Way' sign at that junction.

#### **20/16 Police Attendance**

A Grimsby West Neighbourhood Police Inspector presented an update on the ongoing issues regarding motorbike activity in the area. Multi Agency meetings have taken place and it was reported that Engineering, Education and Enforcement tactics were all discussed at great length. Various plans are now in place to tackle this issue and updates will be given to the Chair regularly to report to the residents.

The Crime report was read out and log numbers were discussed with the Police Inspector.

#### **20/19 Finance**

Three items were paid – Clerks wages, Computer Training and Stationery for Bradley Parish.

## **20/20 Information Exchange**

A member of the public who is currently renting farmland in the parish reported that a resident of the parish has contacted her to enquire about the long term prospects for the land. The member of the public reported that the renting of the land is currently up for tender.

A discussion on the possibility of the parish rejoining the Neighbourhood Watch took place and it was concluded that in the main residents look out for each others properties within the parish.

The parish council reported that it had completed the Waste Disposal Survey requested by NELC as discussed in item number 20/09.

An update on the CCTV system for the parish was given by Chair. The cameras have been ordered and the engineers are currently doing the survey on the relevant streetlights.

It was agreed by all council members that Bradley Parish will continue to pay for two brown bins for the Church at a total of £72 for the coming year.

It was reported that the potholes on bridleway from the fork on Church Lane to Bradley Woods had been marked to for NELC to repair.

All current emergency plan point of contact residents with the exception of one have now completed the relevant paperwork for the new GDPR regulations, it was agreed that a replacement point of contact should be looked into.

As there were some members of the public in attendance who live in the neighbouring Ward it was offered by Chair to keep them updated with events occurring with Bradley Parish Council if email addresses are provided.
