20/24 Declaration of Interest (Local Government Act 2012)

No Declarations of Interest given.

20/25 Minutes of the previous Meetings

Minutes of the Bi-monthly Meeting held on Thursday 5th March 2020 were agreed and signed by Chair.

20/26 Police Matters

There has been a lot of motorbike activity within the village and as previously reported in the AGM of the same date, the CCTV cameras have already been used by the Police to assist in apprehending suspects. The police report was read out by Chair and it stated there had been 3 reported incidences relating to motorbikes. It was agreed that this number was incorrect as two council members and a member of the public had all retained a list of the times and dates that they had telephoned personally. This matter will be pursued.

20/27 Planning Matters

An amendment to Planning Application DM/0056/20/FUL (82 dwellings to be erected at Barnoldby le Beck near Bradley Road) had been received by Bradley Parish Council relating to the design of properties and planting of trees etc. It was agreed that because a letter of objection had already been submitted, nothing more could be done at this time.

The impact of the temporary closure of Tollbar roundabout was discussed and it raised concern about the extra traffic forced to travel down Bradley Road.

20/28 Finance

It was agreed that stationery items purchased by the Clerk will be refunded when the timesheet and receipts are handed in at the end of the month.

The gardening work done at St Georges Church was discussed and it was agreed unanimously that the Gardener should continue with this with a review on the amount for next year discussed at a later date.

20/29 Clerks Update

The clerk attended a remote consultation with NELC, regarding the New Recycling Collection Service, and a brief summary of the consultation had been sent to all councillors. A list of questions has been submitted to NELC relating to the presentation, and there had not been any reply to date.

20/30 Information Exchange

It was agreed by all council members that a donation of £20 would be paid to St Michaels Church for allowing us to use the church for the Bi-monthly meeting.

It was also agreed unanimously that Bradley Parish Council would purchase a mobile telephone for primarily, the Chair, to use for Parish Council business.

Comparisons would be pursued from different network providers and contract or pay as you go options .

The new proposal for the Code of Conduct rules had been emailed to all council members prior to the meeting and no members of the council had any questions regarding the content.

The possible Accessibility Statement for websites, which had been advised by our website designers, was discussed at great length and it was agreed that for the time being, this would not be acted upon.
